God's A, B C Plan For Becoming A Christian

If you are reading this, and you have never received salvation through a personal experience with Christ; that is, you have never been born again (as Jesus speaks about the new birth in John, chapter three), your life has never been changed from the inside out, here is God's Plan For Becoming A Christian.

You could be a member of a church, you could have been baptized, you could even be a worker in the church, you could be a good husband or wife or a good citizen; but if your life has not been changed, there has not been a turning point in your life, you are still living under the penalty and judgment of God for your sins. It is even possible that you could have cleaned up your act, put on a new face; but you are still the same old person inside. If any of these describe your life, here is God's Plan For You!

A- Admit: To admit means; confess to God that you are a sinner. Confessing includes repenting, or turning away from your sins. "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23) "Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out...." (Acts 3:19)

B- Believe: To believe means; trust that Jesus Christ is God's Son and that God sent Jesus to forgive and save people from the eternal punishment of their sins. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved." (John 3:16-17)

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

"Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved...." (Acts 16:31)

C- Commit: To commit means to give your life to Jesus. By faith ask Him to forgive you and be your Saviour and your Lord.

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." (Romans 10:9-10) "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." (Romans 10:13)

Here is a suggested prayer you may say to receive Christ:

"Dear God, I know I have sinned and need forgiveness. Please forgive me for my sins. I accept Jesus as my Saviour and I confess Jesus as Lord of my life. In the name of Jesus I pray, Amen."

After praying to accept Christ, go to a Bible believing church near where you live and tell the pastor that you have accepted Jesus as your Saviour and you want to be baptized (immersed in water) Become an active member of a local Bible Church. (Acts 2:41; Acts 8:38; Hebrews 10:24-25)
